



Minister of Industry, Energy and Mining of Republic of Srpska (RS), Petar Djokić, said in a conversation with delegation of Chinese company CGGC (China Gezhouba Group Corporation), which is a leading company for the construction of energy and infrastructure facilities, that the RS is opened for the new investments, and that the good cooperation can be achieved.
