

Czech group CEZ has increased the social capital of the companies Tomis Team SA and MW Team SRL through which it operates the Fantanele-Cogealac wind park, the largest in Romania.

The shareholders of Tomis Team decided to increase the company's capital by EUR 153 million in mid-February, by converting in shares a debt owned by Tomis Team to CEZ Czech Republic. The Czech group also decided to increase the capital of MW Team by EUR 40 million, reports local [Economica.net](http://Economica.net).

CEZ bought the project for building the Fantanele-Cogealac wind park from Continental Wind Partners LLC in August 2008. The project is located 17-km away from the Black Sea.
